Most of our work occurs in the community, where we support families to create safety and well-being for children and youth. We also provide services, including the Family Violence Counselling Program, the Family Court Support Worker program, the Child Witness Program, the Open Door program, and the Partner Assault Response program (PAR). It is through these services that we work together to create safe children and youth, strong families, caring communities.
